FINANCIAL AID PROCEDURES If you are applying for financial aid for the 2022-2023 school year, there are TWO places you <u>must</u> apply. **The first** is with Empower Illinois <u>https://empowerillinois.org/</u> and **the second** is thru FACTS <u>https://</u> online.factsmgt.com/signin/4HP07.

Empower Illinois registration opened on **Jan 12th at 7PM** and is a two part process. It is important to get step one done on the 12th. Reservation forms are available at 6:30PM so families can be ready to submit at 7PM. The complete application, which requires household documents is available on January 14th, 2022

FACTS does not open until **Feb 1st**. Getting your financial aid requests in early is imperative as funds are available on a first come, first serve basis.
