

#### RE-ENROLLMENT FOR 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR

Currently, we are expecting full classes from Pre-K thru 8th grade next school year. Registering early guarantees your child a space in class. Information will be mailed to your home at the end of December. If you do not receive this or need additional copies, stop by the office. Forms must be completed and signed by both parents. Payment will only be accepted in the form of cash or check. There are no electronic registrations. Please be aware of the following time line for registration:

- **Tuesday, January 4th at 8 a.m**. Reenrollment for Current Students. *No early registration will be taken before this date.*
- Monday, January 10th at 8 a.m. Enrollment for members of St. Paul's Church who are not currently enrolled and siblings of current students begins.
- Tuesday, January 18<sup>th</sup> at 8 a.m. Open Enrollment for New Families

Once open enrollment begins, enrollment is taken on a first-come, firstserved basis.
