

REMINDERS

In order to keep everyone as healthy as possible here at the school, PLEASE keep your child at home if they exhibit any of the following:

- Temperature 100.4 or higher when taken by mouth.
- Sore throat
- New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (for students with chronic allergic/ asthmatic cough from baseline)
- Diarrhea, vomiting or abdominal pain
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever.

If your child exhibits any of these symptoms in order for them to return to school they must be fever and symptom free with no medication for a full 24 hours or one full school day whichever is greater.

Arriving in the morning at 8a.m.: A reminder all individuals walking into the building must be wearing masks.

At 8a.m. only Preschool through Kindergarten should be entering through the south door with a parent walking them into the building.

All 1st-8th grade parents should drop off in the circle drive. If you have a combination of the two groups we ask that you park in the lot and cross over the drive down at the south end of the parking lot. First through eighth grade students in this small group can then walk down the front sidewalk to enter the building. These parents, before leaving the parking lot, should look to see that their child or children have entered the building. All other parents should remain in their cars and drop off in the circle drive. Only parents who have business in the office should park and enter the building. Parents should not try to maneuver around other cars in the circle drive. This could lead to fender benders or other forms of accidents.

CHAPEL - Chapel is Wednesday at 8:30AM. We have a special Chapel project going on until September 30. Chapel offerings will be donated to St. Paul's LWML for Operation Christmas Child. We will also be collecting supplies. More details to come. The offering will help ship the boxes of collected items. Last year we shipped over 100 boxes. This year we would like to do even more!
