**SPORTS PHYSICALS:** If your 5th-8th grader will be playing sports and has not yet had a sports physical, please get that done ASAP. They will not be able to play in any games or events without one!

### MORNING REMINDERS

In order to make the check-in process as safe and as efficient as possible, we ask that you do the following:



**When arriving in the morning at 8:00AM all students are to enter through the main entrance.** We are still allowing preschool and kindergarten parents to walk their children into the building, but please be mindful of the drop-off car line and do not crowd or block the crosswalk. All other parents should remain in their cars and drop off their children via the car line.

**AFTER SCHOOL CHANGES:** As a reminder, any changes to after school care/pick up must be called in to the office by 2:00 daily. We are unable to pass messages to teachers after the 2:00 cut off.



**SICK PROCEDURES:** In order to keep everyone as healthy as possible here at the school, PLEASE keep your children home (and contact the school office!) if they exhibit any of the following:

- Temperature of 100.4 or higher
- Sore throat
- New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (for students with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough from baseline)
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever.

**PICTURE DAY is Friday, September 2nd.** If your child is in the Tuesday-Thursday only preschool class you may come in at 8:15AM to have their picture taken. Otherwise, we will start at 8:30AM. Remember that these pictures will be in the yearbook, so dress accordingly! Fliers were sent home, but you can also order online at [www.vangoghphoto.com](http://www.vangoghphoto.com). Our school code is 20012401. Late orders will be accepted until 3:30PM the Friday of pictures, but if you wish to order after that day there will be additional costs.

**PAYMENTS:** There is a black mailbox labeled "Office Drop Off" next to the office door. Payments and forms can be dropped off here as your child walks past the office. This is a secured locked box! Please make sure to label your payment: lunch, extended care, etc. For the lower grades, payments can be placed in your child's folder and the teachers will bring them to the office. Electronic payments are always welcome on Fast Direct!

**PARTNERSHIP HOURS** have been added to all families' Fast Direct accounts. Remember that the *number* of required hours has not changed, but the *rate* is now \$20 per hour. If you have already submitted hours, those will be credited soon!



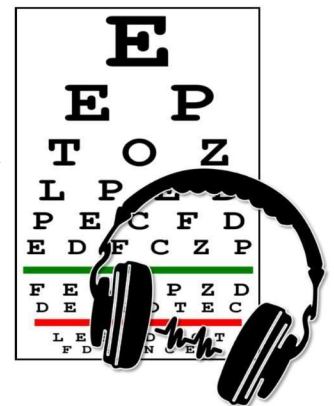

**SCHOOL OFFICE HOURS** are 7:45AM-3:30PM on weekdays.

**CHAPEL SERVICES** are held every Wednesday at 8:30AM. Our chapel offerings through the month of September will be donated to St. Paul's LWML for Operation Christmas Child. We will also be collecting supplies. More details will follow! The offering will help ship the boxes of collected items. Last year we shipped 200 boxes!

**HEARING & VISION SCREENINGS** will be held here at school during regular class time on Wednesday, September 7th. The fee is \$4 per screening, which most parents paid this fee during registration. If you did not, please see Mrs. Olney in the school office. The vision screening will *not* be sufficient for the required vision test for kindergarten students. Those exams need to be given by an optometrist.



**ST. PAUL'S PTL** will be meeting on Tuesday, August 30th at 6:30PM. This meeting is open to all parents and teachers and will be used as a forum for discussion regarding future event dates and co-chairs. We hope you can join us! *Partnership hours are earned for attendance.*
