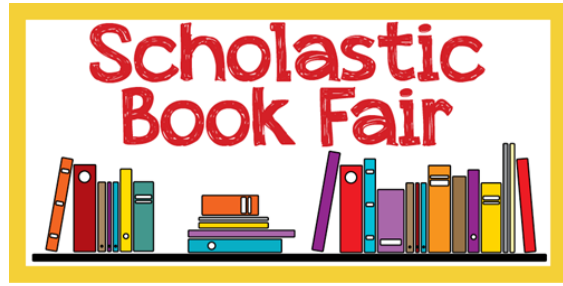

# World Vision

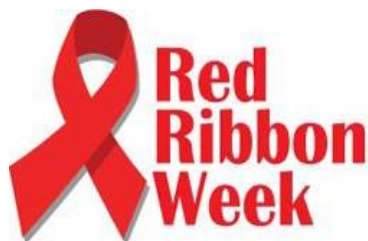
