2022 TAX INFORMATION:

You are able to access your tax information online at any time and print it for your records. Follow these steps:



FACTS: Log into your ac-

count and click the blue "View Details" link. Then select the light blue "View Payment Summary" box. Select the correct year and print.

Fast Direct: Log into your account and select "Finance" in the blue banner at the top. Click on the blue "Tax Report" link on the left. Select the correct year and print.
