Asian – A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent, including for example Cambodia, China, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand, and Vietnam.

Black or African-American – A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.

Two or More Races – A person having origins in more than one race.

Hispanic or Latino – A person of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American, or other Spanish culture.

Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander – A person having origins in any of the original people of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or Pacific Islands.

White – A person having origins in any of the original peoples or Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa.
