### **SAVE THE DATE!**



# "GOD'S FOREVER PROMISE TO DAVID CONTINUES"

When: Every Sunday at 9:50 am

Location: Room 131 Teacher: Pastor Drinnon

Starting September 8<sup>th</sup>, we will be starting a new Bible study on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Kings. These Old Testament books grant us insight into the rise of Solomon's kingdom, the schism between the Northern and Southern Kingdoms, and the eventual destruction of Israel and Judah for their unfaithfulness. Nevertheless, God remains faithful to David and His promises to Him throughout the entire history of the kingdoms of Israel and Judah. God remains faithful even today as David's son, Jesus reigns from heaven.

The Bible study will be exploring these three topics:

1) Faithfulness and Obedience: The central theme throughout both books is the importance of faithfulness to God's promises and obedience to His

commands. Kings who followed God's ways experienced blessings and protection, while those who turned away faced dire consequences.

- 2) Leadership and Responsibility: The kings of Israel and Judah served as both political and spiritual leaders. Their decisions affected not only their own reigns but also the spiritual well-being of the entire nation. This underscores the profound responsibility of leadership in all spheres of life.
- 3) The Preaching of the Word of God: The role of prophets such as Elijah, Elisha, and others is prominently featured in these books. They spoke God's word with authority, calling kings and people alike to repentance and faithfulness. Their lives and ministries demonstrate the power of prophetic obedience and God's faithfulness to His promises.

Although 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Kings are historical books, they continue to be relevant to us today reminding us for the need to be personally faithful to God, the need for faithful leadership, and to listen to the Word of God in aspects of our life. I envision that this study will enrich both newcomers and Bible study veterans alike as we delve deep into God's Word in the books of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Kings.

# NEW BIBLE STUDY: "JESUS' PRAYER LIFE ACCORDING TO THE GOSPELS"

We will cover Jesus' prayer life in the Gospels from His three year ministry as an example for us to follow. Jesus prayed BEFORE all the big events happened in His life. We will look at those moments to understand the power of prayer in His life and how prayer can be a much more powerful part of our daily lives. Jesus needed daily time to have communion with His heavenly Father. Jesus took the time to pray to His Father, even when He was pressured by people. Do YOU take the time to pray each day when you feel pressured by people?

Where did Jesus repeatedly go to pray? Jesus was recharged from praying all night to call His 12 disciples the next day. Why? Great power comes from prayers directed to the one true God.
