SPECIAL VOTERS' MEETING SUMMARY

The Voters' Assembly met on Wednesday, July 16, 2025, with 50 voters in attendance.

At this special Voters' Meeting, there were a number of agenda items:

- **Matching Funds Fund Raising Request** - An anonymous individual has approached us with a matching fund challenge to help with our church and school ministry and our budget realities. Our generous donor has pledged to match up to \$100,000.00 of donations (\$50,000.00 for the General Fund and \$50,000.00 for the Building Fund) which will enable us to raise a total of \$200,000.00 to support St. Paul's Church and School.
As of the Voters' Meeting, we have already had several other generous offers of additional \$1000 matching gifts for both the General and Building Funds.
This fund raising opportunity was approved.
- **2025-2026 Budget** - The final item on the agenda was approval of the 2025-2026 budget which included the Matching Funds Fund Raiser as well as the Brinkmann Endowment Fund Transfer and the loan from the Organ Endowment Fund.
 - With the approval of these items, the budget is basically balanced. While these are all great blessings, we realize that these are one-time solutions.

The Budget and additional items were approved.
