COMING SOON: GIVE AS YOU ARE BLESSED (GUIDED BY THE TITHE)



God comes to us and blesses us. He freely gives us life, families, work,

and faith. Despite our ingratitude and unwillingness to acknowledge that "every good gift and every perfect gift comes from above" (James 1:17), He still blesses us. Our stewardship emphasis this year titled Give as You Are Blessed (Guided by the Tithe) will help remind us that God blesses us to be a blessing to others. A very meaningful way we bless others and express our gratitude to God for all His blessings is through our faithful and generous giving. We give because God gave first. "For God so loved the world that He gave..." (John 3:16). By God's grace, we become givers. When the Holy

Spirit changes our hearts, we come to realize that our heavenly Father has not only created all things, but He also owns, sustains, and provides everything. Most important, He has given us what we needed the most, a Savior.

Our stewardship emphasis, Give as You Are Blessed (Guided by the Tithe), which includes a sermon series and Bible Study, starts on September 20-21. This series will help us grow in the grace of giving as we give proportionately from the resources that God enables us to earn. Giving proportionately means equal sacrifice but not equal gifts. Those with larger incomes can give more than those with smaller incomes. In the Old Testament, God commanded the Israelites to give a tithe, one tenth, from their harvests or produce. Jesus renewed that pledge with the Pharisees in the book of Matthew.

As we meditate on His grace that provides all we need in this world, we are compelled to respond in generous giving and to grow daily in the desire to return to God what He has first given us. To help us grow in the grace of giving, there will be a **TEN for TEN Giving Challenge** (ten percent for ten weeks) that will start immediately after the three-week stewardship emphasis.
