COMING SOON: GIVE AS YOU ARE BLESSED (GUIDED BY THE TITHE)



The theme for Guided by stewardship the Tithe education emphasis is

titled Give as You Are Blessed (Guided by the Tithe). This three-week series will help us understand how important it is for us as God's people to acknowledge Him as the source of all good gifts (James 1:17) and to express our gratitude to Him by giving faithfully for His generosity. God wants us to give as we are blessed, so how much should we give? The tithe (giving one-tenth of our incomes) helps us answer that question. In the Old Testament, God commanded the tithe, and, in the New Testament, Jesus affirms the tithe (Matthew 23:23). By God's grace, many Christians tithe. Tithing is a guide or Biblical benchmark for our faithful giving.

Through faith, we are enabled to respond to God's love, grace, and mercy by giving proportionately from the blessings that He entrusts to us.

To help you grow in the grace of giving, we will be offering a TEN for TEN Giving Challenge (ten percent for ten weeks) following our three-week emphasis. This giving challenge is a time for self-examination. Does your current giving reflect your gratitude for who God is and what He has done and this year's continues to do for you?
